

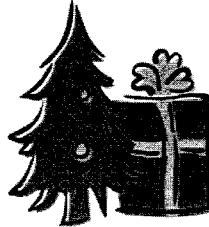

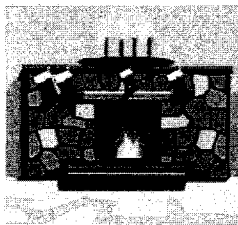

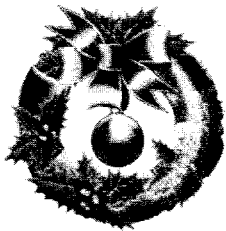
JKHF also sponsored, at the Blackberry Festival, the appreciated military exhibit and provided a viewing opportunity of recently acquired Juliaetta photos.

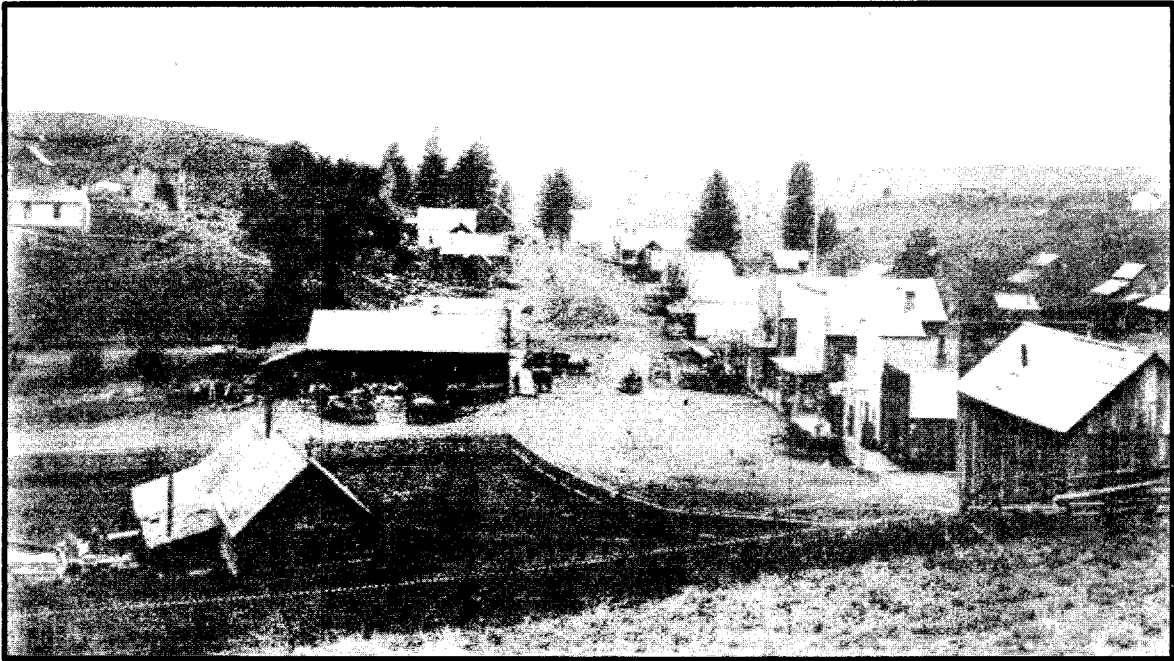
